

# Eden Central Driver Education Summer 2022

Students must be 16 years of age AND have a valid learner's permit by June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022 to be eligible to participate.

Participation in Driver Education is a privilege. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and could dismiss you from participation. The program will begin July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and run through July 28<sup>th</sup>. The cost of this course is \$500.00 and must be paid in full at the time of registration. There are no refunds. Selection to participate is done on a first come first serve basis by grade. Registration is as follows:

Open registration begins March 1<sup>st</sup>. Registration form and payment is due in full.

Students will be expected to meet the following requirements:

1. 24 hours of classroom instruction
2. 24 hours of road instruction

This program will run at the **Eden Senior High** School. All students are required to provide their own transportation to and from the school. No pickups and/or drop-offs will be made at home.

Please note: Attendance doesn't ensure the certificate of completion. Each student must successfully complete the program, participate in class, complete all assignments and pass the tests.

Classroom and driving sessions will usually be held Monday through Friday each week. Please be sure that jobs, vacation, sports, and clubs, do not interfere with your schedule. These are unexcused absences. Driver Education has a zero tolerance attendance policy.

Return the completed form with parental signature, student's signature and your check/money order (no cash) for the full amount payable to Eden Central Schools to the District Office at Eden Elementary School in Room 119.

# COURSE EXPECTATIONS FOR DRIVER EDUCATION

**TEXTBOOK:** Drive Right Curriculum Textbook

## **LECTURE REQUIREMENTS:**

- **Textbook(s)**
- **Pen and Pencil**
- **Notebook**
- **Notepaper**

**ATTENDANCE:** Students must attend ALL (16) lecture classes. This is a requirement of the DMV, the State Education Department and may NOT be waived by the school district. Being late over 10 minutes will count as an absence. There is no make-up time available.

**GRADING:** Tests, papers, and classroom participation all count. Students will be required to take a final exam. Students must have all sessions to be eligible for “Blue Card” and insurance certificate. In addition, a 75% average is required in all areas to obtain a “Blue Card”.

**HOMEWORK:** Classroom reading and study is required as per master schedule handed out at first class.

**FROM THIS COURSE YOU WILL RECEIVE:** **DMV 278** – 5 hour pre-licensing certificate (please notify your classroom instructor if you need one.) This allows you to sign up for your road test.

**DMV 285** – Indicates successful completion of an approved course in driver education and allows eligibility for reduction of insurance premium (To receive a “DMV 285”, the student must pass both the road and lecture requirements.)
