Reading Class Mrs. Doctor Eden Middle and High School

Course Description: This class involves in depth reading. The goal of this class is to give students the opportunity to improve reading skills through increased comprehension, building vocabulary, making inferences, finding main ideas, scanning, summarizing, paraphrasing and analyzing diverse reading selections. In addition, students will learn test taking skills, reading strategies, writing skills, and independent study skills.

Supplies Needed: The most important supplies are your Chromebook, charger and headphones. There will be no borrowing from your teacher or other students. Students should be prepared with blue or black ink pens, pencils, two different colored highlighters, loose-leaf paper, and a journal. Students will also need a book for pleasure reading throughout the year.

It is important that each student has his or her agenda with them everyday to keep track of homework assignments, project due dates, and test and quiz dates. The agendas must be labeled with the student's name, and must be kept intact throughout the school year.

Make-up Policy for Class Work:

You will have the opportunity to make up work in class. There will not be homework for reading class.

Vacations: If your student is going to miss school due to a vacation, work will be collected and given to your student after they return to school.

Music Students: If a student has a music lesson or scheduled music event during Reading class, the student should stop by and notify me before class. Students will be responsible to write down classwork at that time. All work is expected to be complete for the next class day.

Behavioral Expectations: Students must behave in a way that is conducive to a positive learning environment for themselves and their classmates. Sugared drinks are not permitted in the classroom. It is school policy that students caught cheating in any form, including plagiarism, will be given a zero for the assignment or test, and their parents will be contacted.
