Step 4: Presentation

Make 10 Power Point Slides:

- ✓ Introductory slide with your name, period, and topic you researched
- ✓ Your claim
- ✓ 3 researched details that support your claim; these details should all be on a separate slide
- ✓ A counterclaim
- ✓ Two details that support the counterclaim; these should be on a separate slide
- ✓ A slide that explains why the counterclaim is wrong
- ✓ Five Key Terms and their definitions
