- **SERVICES DESIGNED TO IMPROVE ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE**
 - **IMPLEMENTATION OF MULTI-TIERS SYSTEM OF SUPPORTS (MTSS)**
SYSTEMATIC CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT FRAMEWORK IN WHICH DATA-BASED PROBLEM SOLVING AND DECISION-MAKING IS PRACTICES ACROSS ALL LEVELS OF AN EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM FOR SUPPORTING STUDENTS.

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) -REPORTING

- LEAs shall identify any programs utilizing such funding that are expected to continue beyond the availability of such federal funds and **identify local funds that will be used to maintain such programs** in order to minimize disruption to core academic and other school programs.
- **CAUTION: If our plan spends all the funds on new initiatives we may not have local funds to identify to maintain the programs, hence the advice not to use for recurring costs.**
