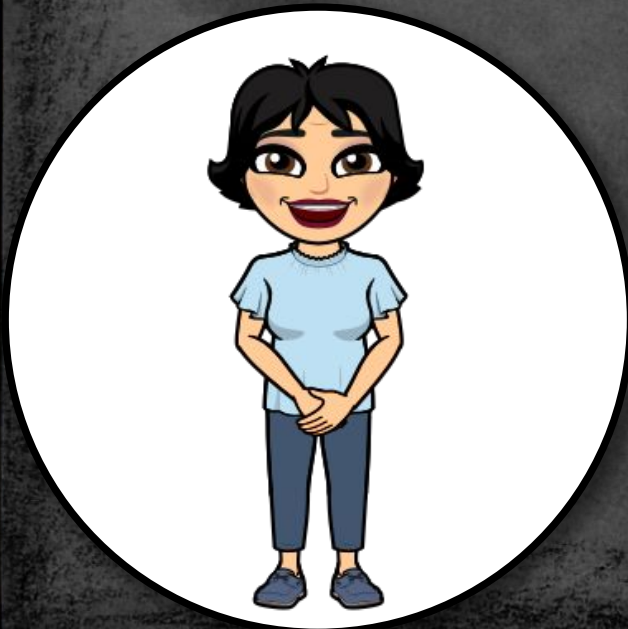

CLASSROOM POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Class Dojo will be utilized to communicate with parents regularly. We send out reminders, pictures, and behavior updates through this app.

We also use Class Dojo for class behavior. If students do not lose points all week, they will receive a Raider ticket for a chance to win our classroom fish at the end of the year.

CLASSROOM POLICIES & **PROCEDURES**

Take Home Folders should be cleaned out after each day. Any notes or work being returned to school should be placed in the Take Home Folder and sent to school with your child.

IRLA Reading Logs need to be completed and signed each day. Each student should be reading at home for 2 steps for a total of 30 minutes each day. Please make sure their log is sent to school each day as we will also be completing two steps at school.

Please make sure your child has a plastic water bottle with them each day. There are drinking fountains available in the hallways.

Also, please make sure your child wears sneakers to school each day. They have Physical Education each day and outside play, weather permitting .
